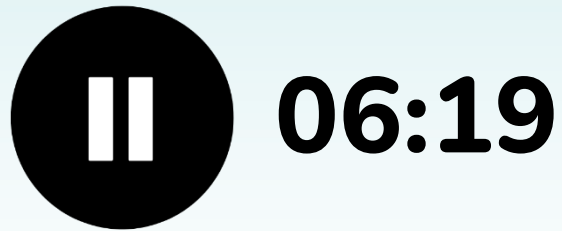

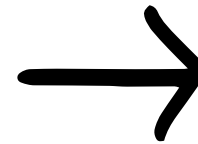


Brainstorm Session
