KIDZWORLD IN THE CLASSROOM

SHOW AND TELL

Spark a discussion on the various occupations featured in the show with your class and organise a show and tell day where children get to dress up as their favourite specialist.



Allow children to express themselves by choosing their favourite occupation and dress up however they like!

DRAMATIC CORNER SETUP

Create your very own KidzWorld in the classroom to extend your student's imagination in their chosen role.



Get the children to learn about taking up responsibilities as they assume their job roles and complete tasks at their "KidzWorld".

VETERINARIAN



His role:

- Diagnose and treat sick or injured animals
- Conduct regular health check ups for animals
- Vaccinate animals to prevent them from getting sick

Get your young veterinarians to use medical equipment such as stethoscopes, bandages and syringes to diagnose and treat sick animals at the vet corner.



Treating a wound on an animal is similar to how you would treat a wound on a person – clean the wound and apply antiseptic medication to it.

ANIMAL TRAINER



Her role:

- Host animal presentations at KidzWorld
- Feed the animals and clean their homes
- Keep them mentally and physically active
- Train them to do certain behaviours which help us conduct body checks on them more easily

Get your young animal trainers to host animal presentations and wow the audience with the animals' amazing abilities!

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We train our animals using a method called positive reinforcement: when the animal obeys our instruction, we reward it with a 'click' of our clicker and a treat! If it does not obey, we do not punish it and try the instruction again a little later.

ANIMAL NUTRITIONIST



Her role:

- Write diet plans for each type of animal in the Zoo
- Work with the vets and animal trainers to create special diets for animals that are sick, pregnant or at a sensitive age

Invite your young animal nutritionists to prepare food for hungry animals in the class!



Animal nutritionists must know the natural diet of the animals under their care, and understand which nutrients are important to keep them healthy.
